Southern Door 3 on 3 Rules

1. Each game will be 20-minutes in length;
2. We will run one clock per gym for all courts in that gym. The clock will stop at the 10-minute mark for a 90-second timeout and again at the 5-minute mark for another 90-second timeout. Other than these 2-timeouts the clock will run continuously;
3. Any shot outside the arc counts for 2-points. All other field goals and free throws count as 1-point;
4. After 7th team foul, penalty is in effect, 1-free throw is shot for all fouls thereafter. (If fouled and shot goes in, basket is awarded and defense gets the ball. After 7th foul basket would count and 1-free throw is awarded.) 1-pt is awarded to defense and ball possession to defense for intentional stalling at the sole discretion of the official;
5. Ball must be checked after each score - ball will be immediately in play after checking. Ball can then be dribbled, passed or shot;
6. After a change of possession ball must be taken back to a point anywhere beyond the 3-point arc;
7. Tie game after 20-minutes, each team member will shoot 1-free throw, team making the most free throws wins. Ref will flip a coin to determine who shoots first;
8. Technical fouls, 1-automatic point for opponent plus possession of ball;
9. Pool winners advance to championship games;
Pool tie breakers: 1.Head to Head competition
2. Free Throws
10. Official will flip coin previous to start time to determine initial Possession;
11. When clock is set, horn will blow to begin games;
12. Substitutions can be sent into game on any dead ball;
13. 6th Grade and younger, along with all girls will use the 28.5" ball;
14. Free throws for 5th grade and younger can be shot from 13-ft line;
15. Teams are responsible to be at their scheduled courts and ready to go when whistle blows;
16. Teams will play in the division of the oldest player (i.e. teams with 2-7th graders and 2-8th graders will play in 8th grade brackets);
17. **SDABC will supply all Basketballs - no carry-ins allowed;**
18. Good sportsmanship will be enforced;
19. Only 4-team members per team;
